She also has an interest in blues music and performed with Aberdeen-based blues band Off the Tracks, and her work often features close harmony arrangements. Janice has taught at Folk Festivals throughout Scotland and has been a regular tutor at the Adult Feis, teaching guitar, traditional song and harmony, and also tutors for Scottish Culture and Traditions in Aberdeen.

# Angus Folk Song Session

Saturday September 15<sup>th</sup> 2007, Wester Caputh Hostel, Perthshire.

In the afternoon, Janice Clark will teach a class from 1 – 5pm in the village hall. The cost of the workshop will be £6 for Angus Folk members, £8 for non-members. Following that, at about 7pm, we'll have a shared buffet meal (produced by everyone bringing along a plate to contribute). In the evening, there will be an informal session - time to chat and share music. Additional folk, partners, singing friends and musicians might like to come along and join in the session. Next morning, for those who want to stay, we'll have breakfast, tidy up and leave by lunchtime.

There's a large main room with a piano and various other instruments, a large table (seats 16+ but perfect for a buffet if there's more) varied seating and a wood-burning stove. The kitchen is at one end of this room. Cutlery and crockery are provided.

The hostel sleeps 17 (or 18 if there's two in the double bed) in full-size bunk beds. Rooms are 1 x 6 beds, 2 x 2 beds, 1 x 3 beds and 1 x 4 beds). The hostel has 3 toilets and 2 showers. Bed linen is provided. Towels are not provided. Additional beds in twin and double rooms may be available in the house next to the hostel if we need more space.

An alternative source of nearby accommodation, possibly en suite, is a B&B in Stralochy, (about 2 miles away). Contact Agnes Smith: telephone 01738 710447.

The hostel is set in a really nice spot for short walks or bike rides for anyone who thinks that they may need to escape at any time! There are also picnic tables outside if the weather is good.

Since the accommodation is limited, beds will be booked on a first-come, first-served basis – so apply early. It will cost £20 per head for bed and breakfast. To let us gauge interest and book beds, please fill in the following section and post to....

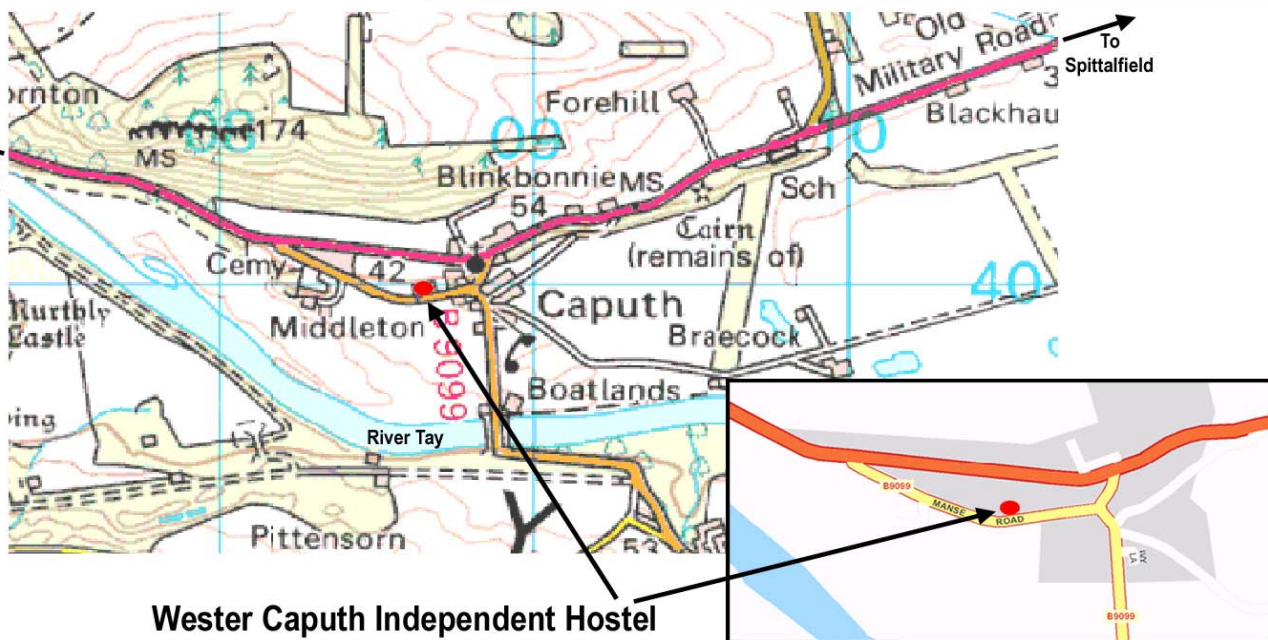
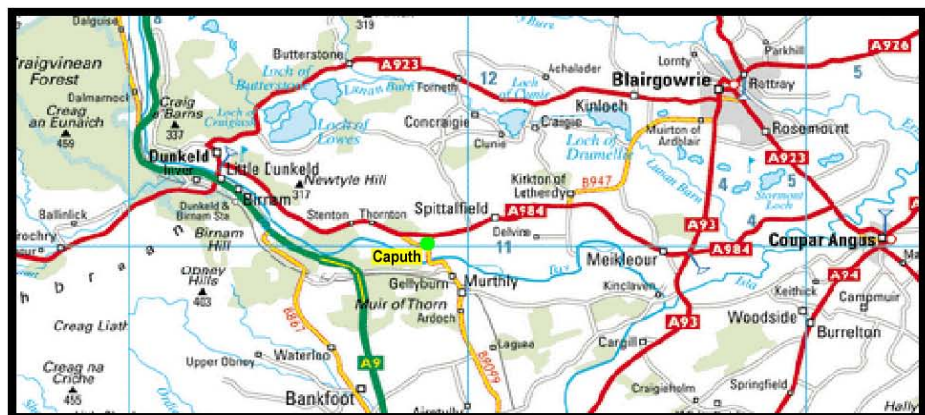
## Directions to Wester Caputh independent Hostel

### ***From the A9:***

Take the Dunkeld/Birnam exit, and turn right (signposted Caputh/Coupar Angus A984) as soon as you cross the bridge as you enter Dunkeld (in front of the Taybank Hotel). Follow this road for four miles and take a right at the B9099 (signposted Murthly/Stanley). Pass the churchyard, pass a raspberry field and as you veer round to the left you'll see the farmhouse and hostel on the left (long white building).

### ***From Coupar Angus / Blairgowrie:***

Follow the A984 (from Coupar Angus) or the A93 (from Blairgowrie) to Meikleour and then take the A984 to Dunkeld. Pass through Spittalfield and the next village is Caputh. Turn left turn onto the B9099 signposted to Murthly/Stanley. After only a few yards, turn right. The hostel and farmhouse are on your right hand side a short distance along this road, just beyond the national speed limit sign.
